


Fig. 1 - Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage




Fig. 2 - Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage




Fig. 3 - Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage






Fig. 4 - Diode Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage
